

CAMERON AND KERRY'S MINISTRY ACCOUNTABILITY STRUCTURE WITH SERVANT LEADERS

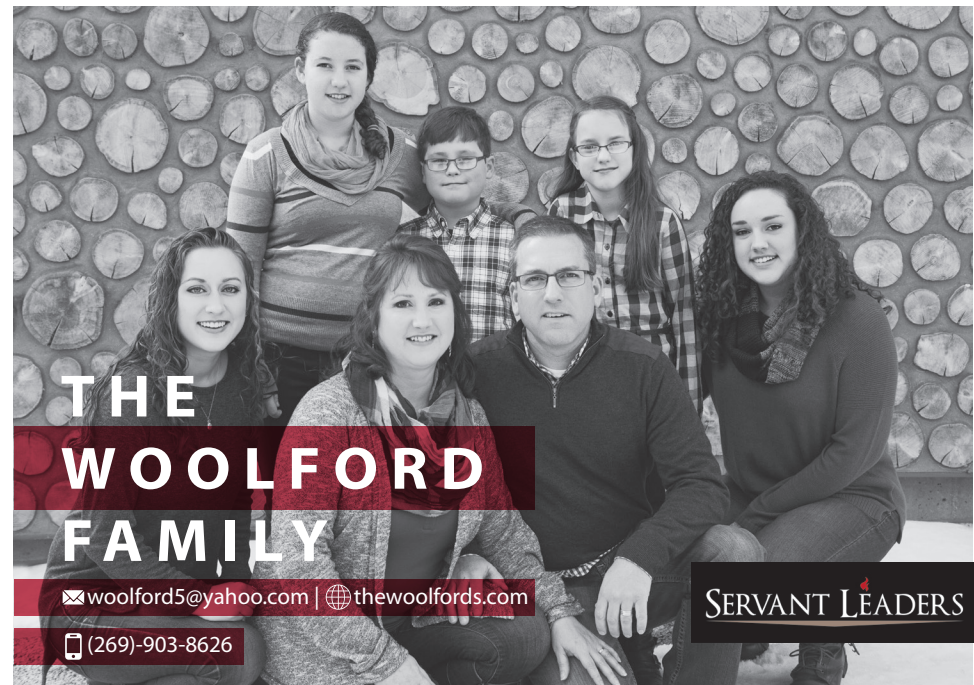
- 1. Sending Church :** The Local Church is the New Testament authority over all ministry. The Woolford family acts under the authority of Midway Baptist Church as an extension of their ministry.
- 2. Servant Leaders Tactical Team:** A leadership team of 5 partnership local church pastors and missionaries provide oversight to Servant Leaders and the Woolford family. This team meets at different levels weekly to oversee operational and strategic decisions that occur on a day to day basis.
- 3. Servant Leaders Strategic Team:** A leadership team of partnering churches and missionaries provide oversight to the mission of Servant Leaders. They help to provide accountability to the Woolford family as well as overall Servant Leaders Ministries leadership of areas such as finance and direction. This team meets twice a year.
- 4. Partnering Churches:** The Woolford family is responsible to continually report to their partnering churches. Partnering church pastors will be given a strategic plan that will be both measurable and practical for each year.

MINISTRY MILESTONES

1995-2005 Ecuador: Cameron and Kerry help to plant 3 local churches, train national pastors and ministry leaders in a formal Bible institute setting.

2007-2012 Costa Rica: Cameron and Kerry help to plant Living Rock Baptist Church in the southern mountains of Costa Rica. They help to establish and local church based ministry training system.

2012-Present: Cameron helped to launch Servant Leaders Ministry to assist the local church in Latin America to create local church based ministry training and begin to see churches plant churches.

SERVANT LEADERS

The local church is central to accomplishing the mission of God. He has established the centrality of the local church as the crucial piece to reaching a lost world. Charles Spurgeon stated it clearly when he said, "The church is the world's hope! As Christ is the hope of the church, so the church is the hope of the world". The problem is that many churches never recognize their role as central to God's plan in the world. There are many places in the world today where there is a lack of infrastructure and resources for the local church to be able to fulfill its mission in the Great Commission's call to plant churches. For this reason many churches in places such as Latin America never see a new church born out of their community of faith. Servant Leaders exists to partner with the local church to assist them in recognizing, refining and releasing its ministry and leadership potential. The vision is a church culture, where the local church takes the primary responsibility for the training and mobilization of its members. This results in a healthy local church capable of reproduction through the launching on new local churches and the sending out of missionaries.

HOW SERVANT LEADERS ASSISTS LOCAL CHURCHES

- 1. Onsite Local Church Theological and Ministerial Training.** We have created a network of missionaries and pastors who travel to partnering churches to conduct training. We currently have 8 teaching partners assisting in the local church training in 3 countries.
- 2. Formal Online Programs.** Servant Leaders is collaborating with Pilgrimage Educational Resources to develop academic tracks aligned with Servant Leaders training. The Collaboration will provide further opportunities for our Latin American national leaders to pursue higher levels of competency and credentials within the scope of their local church ministry calling. Our goal is to run a pilot of the program this Fall.
- 3. Local Church Ministry and Leadership Training Tools.** We have created a training curriculum that contains 21 courses that assist the local church to take someone from learning how to lead themselves with spiritual discipline, to participation with others in local church ministry, to leading in different ministry roles, to training leaders at the local church level.

Websites in English, Spanish and Portuguese support the local churches providing them with reproducible resources for training men and women in the context of their local church.
www.ethnos2819.org is a ministry mentoring platform that we created for our partnering local churches. This platform provides the local church with a tool to organize and run all of their ministry mentoring. All of our Servant Leaders material in English, Spanish and Portuguese are housed and delivered on this platform. The local church can also upload their own material such as a membership training or deacon training, etc.
- 4. Church To Church Great Commission Partnerships.** The Woolfords have been developing Great Commission partnerships over the past 8 years. These partnerships consist of two churches coming together for the purpose of fulfilling the call of Great Commission together. This happens through sharing of resources and personnel to encourage and mobilize the church. We have successfully created partnerships between churches in the US with churches in Latin America, churches in South America with churches in Central America as well as church to church partnerships within the USA.
- 5. Leadership and Ministry Mentoring.** Many pastors in Latin America have never been trained in basic leadership and ministry skills. We come alongside to help them develop the skills necessary to lead their churches and to reproduce leaders and local churches.
